Steps for Writing an Ode

An ode is a poem that tells in an original way what is good or unique about a subject and why the writer likes it so much. You will write about your favorite cube (or prism). Have Fun!

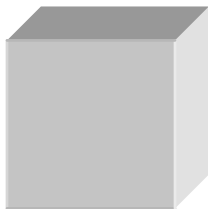
Write phrases describing:

- Explain why your cube is important to you
- Optionally include a picture and/or other artwork
- $\frac{1}{2}$ page to a full page in length - handwritten is ok
- Remember, it does not have to rhyme!

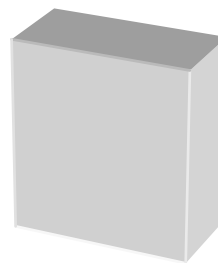


*"Cub-e-o, oh cub-e-o,
